**SPECIAL ACT NO. 79-35**

**ACT VALIDATING THE COMPLETION OF CERTAIN DUTIES OF THE  
RD OF TAX REVIEW AND TOWN CLERK OF THE TOWN OF  
HERSFIELD WITHIN AN EXTENDED PERIOD OF TIME.**

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 2-14 of the general  
tes, concerning the enactment of special legislation by the general assembly,  
ime within which certain actions as described in sections 2, 3 and 4 of this act  
be performed in accordance with the applicable sections of the general statutes,  
ended as provided in this act and said actions performed in accordance with the  
sions of this act are hereby validated and made binding upon the town of  
ersfield.

Sec. 2. The time within which the board of tax review of the town of  
ersfield shall determine the appeals of all taxpayers claiming to be aggrieved  
e doings of the assessor of said town in making assessments for and upon the  
l list of 1978, and complete its doings on all matters pending before it is  
ided to May 15, 1979. Said board shall mail each appellant written notice of the  
sition of such appellant's appeal within one week after said date. Any person  
ing to be aggrieved by the action of said board may appeal therefrom within  
nonths from the date of the action by said board as provided in section 12-118  
e general statutes.

Sec. 3. Nothing in this act shall affect such rights as any taxpayer may  
to relief under the provisions of section 12-119 of the general statutes, and the  
for initiating any action for relief under said section is extended to December 1.

Sec. 4. The time within which the town clerk is required to transmit a  
ct of the assessment lists to the tax commissioner as provided in section 12-120  
e general statutes is extended to May 31, 1979.

**SPECIAL ACT NO. 79-36**

**CT AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF A PARCEL OF LAND FROM  
STATE TO ISABEL AND JAMES JACKSON OF WESTBROOK.**

The state treasurer is authorized, upon approval of the department of  
: safety, to convey a certain parcel of land, for a price to be determined by the  
reasurer, to James and Isabel Jackson of Westbrook, Connecticut, which land

House Bill No. 7403

**SPECIAL ACT NO. 79-37**

**AN ACT VALIDATING CERTAIN ACTS OF THE ASSESSOR OF THE TOWN OF  
ROXBURY.**

Notwithstanding section 12-107e of the general statutes and consistent  
with the intent of an amendment to the town plan of development adopted by the  
Roxbury planning commission effective December 15, 1978, the acceptance by the  
assessor of the town of Roxbury, at any time prior to January 31, 1979, of any written  
application for classification of land as open space land, provided such land is  
included in the area designated as open space land in accordance with said  
amendment, which application, if such classification were to be effective with  
respect to the assessment list for 1978, should have been filed with said assessor not  
later than October 31, 1978, as provided in said section 12-107e and which  
application was not so filed because said amendment was not adopted until after  
October 31, 1978, is validated. Said assessor is further authorized to include such  
land, classified as open space land, in the assessment list for 1978, if approved by  
said assessor for classification in accordance with said section 12-107e, subject to the  
extension of time for filing as provided in this act.

House Bill No. 7930

**SPECIAL ACT NO. 79-39**

**AN ACT CONCERNING THE MEETINGS OF THE GUILFORD LAKES  
IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION.**

Section 7 of number 167 of the special acts of 1963, as amended by section  
1 of number 396 of the special acts of 1967, is amended to read as follows:

Annual meetings shall be held [on the first Monday in March] NOT  
EARLIER THAN THE FIRST DAY NOR LATER THAN THE TENTH DAY OF  
MARCH, at such time and place within the town of Guilford as the board of  
governors may direct. Any vacancy occurring in the membership of said board of  
governors, between annual meetings of the association, shall be filled by a majority  
of the remaining members of the board until the next annual meeting, at which time  
the members of the association shall elect, as above prescribed, a member of the  
board for the unexpired portion of the term.
