

Guilford Lakes Improvement Association
Rules and Regulations
for Docks, Rafts, & Inflatables

1. Docks and rafts may not be affixed to the lake bottom. All docks and rafts must be safely secured to the owner's property at the water line.
2. The total area of water covered by the combination of dock, raft, or inflatable is not to exceed 96 sq. per household. Docks, rafts, or inflatable's may not exceed 12 feet in length, width or diameter.
3. No portion of any anchored dock, raft or inflatable may extend 20 feet beyond the property's water line.
4. Docks require written approval from the Guilford Inland Wetland Commission and Guilford Lakes Improvement Association Board of Directors.
5. Replacement of or alterations to existing docks or rafts must conform to rules and regulations.
6. Any electrical wiring on docks must meet town code.
7. GLIA property owners are responsible for any dock, raft or inflatable they put in or on the water and may be held liable for any damage to GLIA common property or the property of other residents. Any inflatable raft brought in thru beach access must be removed at end of day.

GLIA is not responsible for damage to any docks, rafts or inflatables.

Any home owner not able to meet these regulations must apply for a variance from the GLIA Board of Directors.
