## **VOLUNTARY SHORT-TERM RENTAL REGISTRATION**

GLIA homeowners who rent their homes on a short-term basis are allowed to have renters use the beaches, provided the renters abide by all GLIA rules and regulations. In order for Beach Guards to more readily confirm that a guest on the beach is currently renting a property, GLIA has come up with a voluntary registry of short-term rental homes.

The goal of the registry is to make the beach experience easier for renters, property owners and Beach Guards.

- Homeowners must provide renters with the GLIA Beach Rules prior to any beach access.
- Upon arrival at the beach, renters must be able to provide Beach Guard with proof of property being rented and dates of rental (either a screenshot, email or printed rental confirmation).
- Renters must obey all GLIA rules and regulations or they will be asked to leave the beach.
- ❖ Beach Guards have the authority to call the Guilford Police to remove trespassers from the beach.
